PERGOLA

La Pérgola Clandestina, located in the heart of Cali, proudly defines itself as a "100% made in Cali" project. In this bar, which also offers gastronomic delights, urban, tropical, and electronic sounds dominate.



La topa **TOLONDRA**

La Topa Tolondra An iconic venue considered the temple of Cali salsa. This nightclub is the epicenter where music lovers, tourists, and salsa enthusiasts gather to enjoy great performances or take salsa classes.

JORGE ISAACS

The Jorge Isaacs Theater, built in 1931 and declared a national monument in 1984, is located in the historic center of Santiago de Cali, opposite Ortiz Bridge and Los Poetas Park, and next to La Ermita Church. Here, you can attend theatrical, artistic, and cultural performances visiting our city.







The Farallones of Cali are home to life-giving springs, ancestral lands, and cultural exchanges. These are the youngest rock formations in the Western Andes. Additionally, the area offers education, research, monitoring, recreation, and ecotourism services, making it an excellent destination for observing flora, fauna, and a wide variety of bird species, ideal for bird watching enthusiasts.
